Major Projects

- Solidify the course representative system: we had a full implementation of our student feedback app, Unitu. This helped to clarify the structure of the course rep system, as well as create a clear understanding for all students of where to go with any student issues.
- Increase the Student Union's presence on campus: we have taken the steps into developing our own 'Student Union' Module on Blackboard. With the support from the blackboard, we have now established this module and now are gathering all of the material that will be uploaded on the module. This will range from council updates to our academic and social events calendars for each month. This new mode of communication aims to increase student union awareness, as well as increase student participation and engagement.
- Launch of the Student HIVE: The SU worked alongside the Employability and Student Enterprise Manager in the launching of the Hive. The originally scheduled launch was on the 1st of March, which, due to the snow, had to be postponed with a new launch date on the 17th of April.
- Bring support for the NSS: Student Union Executives visited classrooms to engage with all of the eligible cohorts and explain the benefit of the NSS, as well as encouraging students to complete it. All executives put in even more work outside of the classroom.
- Clearer PCM guidelines: SU worked with both faculties BAM and HASS to accomplish this goal

Through the councils, we started the implementation of Unitu to all the students on campus, to establish a clear feedback loop for student issues.
